Dues Increase update: The Island Woods 2023 budget is based on maintenance and upkeep costs anticipated for the year. A 10% dues increase during the April billing cycle was necessary to balance this year's budget. However, some homeowners questioned the legitimacy of the increase, so after a thorough review of the CC&R's and Bylaws, the Board determined that a 10% increase was allowable during the 2nd quarter billing cycle, but not the 1st, thus creating a \$9,000 deficit. Due to a very tight budget the Board's priorities are maintenance and upkeep along with issues relating to safety, liability and dead trees. This presents few options for budget adjustments requiring the Board to consider redirecting funds from the pool and/or Christmas lights budgets if the deficit necessitates it.

Please plan on attending the bi-annual Homeowner's Meeting with the Board (date and time to be announced in next quarter's newsletter) as the main topic of discussion is expected to be the budget.



After researching management companies and interviewing a handyman for the position, the Board decided that longtime resident and Board Member, Jill Barbour, will continue as Property Manager for the duration of the year.

Homeowners, the time for yard beautification is fast approaching, please remember common areas are not a collection area for your yard debris. Please dispose of leaves, branches and pulled weeds from your yard properly.
